



Cork CIL Travel Club

Cork-Centre for Independent Living (Cork CIL) 'Travel Club' offers members access to a wheelchair accessible, door to door transport service for appointments or for social activities.

IMPORTANT: This is not a Taxi service but a 'Travel Club'.

Cork CIL Travel Club has wheelchair accessible mini buses. We are capable of carrying two wheelchair users (depending on the size of the chair) plus three to four seated passengers. The Travel Club currently operates five days a week Monday to Friday in Cork city and close suburbs. If there is demand and capacity, we hope to extend this to evenings and weekend service.

MEMBERSHIP OF CORK CIL TRAVEL CLUB

Membership of the 'Travel Club' is open to people with a disability, Cork CIL service users, other people with a disability who live in Cork, their family and friends.

The Travel Club is not a service that is eligible for HSE funding and we must ensure that the cost of running the club is fully covered including booking centre, fuel, insurance, vehicle maintenance etc. This is only possible with members contributions

- There is membership fee for the Travel Club of €60. Your first local trip will be free and after that if you book a trip with the Travel Club you will be asked for a contribution for each journey.
- You will be able to book up to a maximum of 4-four weeks in advance of your journey.
- Unfortunately, if you cancel with less than 24 hours notice we will have to charge you
- If member is in arrears of more that 4-four weeks we will not be able to accept bookings
