



## Cork CIL Travel Club

Cork-Centre for Independent Living (Cork CIL) 'Travel Club' offers members access to a wheelchair accessible, door to door transport service for appointments or for social activities.

Cork CIL Travel Club has wheelchair accessible mini buses. Normally we are capable of carrying two wheelchair users (depending on the size of the chair) plus three to four seated passengers.

### COVID-19 CHANGES

As a result of Covid-19 we are limited to one vehicle. This vehicle is fitted with a cough screen and is cleaned after each passenger. We can carry 1-one wheelchair user. They can be accompanied by one other person from the same household or we can accommodate 1-one-foot passenger. We regret no-one may travel alongside the driver and all shopping must be carried in the main bus.

The Travel Club currently operates five days a week Monday to Friday in Cork city and close suburbs. **Call 087 102 3530 to request a journey**

#### MEMBERSHIP OF CORK CIL TRAVEL CLUB

Membership of the 'Travel Club' is open to people with a disability, Cork CIL service users, other people with a disability who live in Cork, their family and friends.

The Travel Club is not a service that is eligible for HSE funding and we must ensure that the cost of running the club is fully covered including booking centre, fuel, insurance, vehicle maintenance etc. This is only possible with members contributions

- There is membership fee for the Travel Club of €60. Your first local trip will be free and after that if you book a trip with the Travel Club you will be asked for a contribution for each journey.
- You will be able to book up to a maximum of 1-one weeks in advance of your journey.
- If you have a confirmed hospital appointment, please talk to the Travel Club Organiser 087 102 3530. We may take an advance booking of 4 weeks but will ask you to confirm within 1 week that you still wish to travel
- Unfortunately, if you cancel any booked journey with less than 24 hours' notice we will have to charge you

- You will be asked for contribution for each journey If possible, please use contactless pay or have the exact money We cannot handle change at the moment. If you cannot manage this, we will send you an invoice.
- If member is in arrears of more that 4-four weeks we will not be able to accept bookings
